### Development Background / Rationale

A Chinese medicine (GengShuAn Granule) based on an ancient prescription for relieving menopausal syndrome: - a safer Chinese medicine for women suffering from menopausal syndrome to replace Estrogen Replacement Therapy (ERT) which has been reported to be associated with incidences of breast and ovary cancers, coronary diseases, stroke and pulmonary embolism.



### Special Product Features / Technical Excellence

- Optimised formulation with enhanced safety profile (patents pending, US, PRC, and HK).
- *In vivo* and *In vitro* models showed estrogen-like effect in anti-anxiety, anti-depression, anti-oxidation, memory and sleeping enhancement.
- Adopted advanced extraction methodologies and technologies and a quality control framework to meet the regulatory requirements in mainland China and potentially, USA and Europe.
